Agencies access a wide and complex range of applications, databases, and devices to meet the demands of ministerial, internal and citizen stakeholders.

- The amount of process generated data created daily across
 Government, and the lack of system inter-operability, means data
 sharing for the majority is problematic limits deeper analysis and
 insights.

Gold Partner Session: Cloud tales: Lessons from a cyber incident response team

Cloud migration strategies can be complex. Moving to flexible multi-cloud platforms and hybrid models can be daunting and expensive and implementing security throughout agile software development lifecycles is becoming difficult. But if executed well migrating workloads to the cloud lowers infrastructure costs and introduces efficiencies. Almost two-thirds (61 per cent) of respondents to research questions posed by Cybersecurity Insiders,, had integrated their DevOps toolchain into cloud deployments, but are still struggling with a lack of expertise that bridges security and DevOps. Only 16 per cent have comprehensive DevSecOps environments already in place.




