Program compliance administration is an intensive process which is difficult to navigate and fraught with approval delays. Legacy platforms add to the complexity through their lack of integration and inability to leverage process automation, messaging, data analytics and Al. Flexible open source and low/code no code platforms have helped to transform program compliance administration. 
