CompTIA Network+ Modules Breakdown:

Networking Concepts

- Explain the purpose and functions of various network devices and the OSI model layers
- Understand and apply networking protocols, including TCP/IP
- Differentiate between types of network topologies and network services

Infrastructure

- Install and configure routers and switches
- Understand the different types of transmission media, including copper, fiber, and wireless
- Implement WAN technologies and network segmentation, such as VLANs

Network Operations

- Use network monitoring tools and analyze metrics to ensure performance and connectivity
- Manage network documentation and diagrams
- Understand disaster recovery principles, including backup and restore procedures

Networking Security

- Apply security best practices to network devices to protect data integrity
- Implement network security protocols and authentication methods
- Configure firewalls and intrusion detection/prevention systems to secure network traffic

Network Troubleshooting and Tools

- Troubleshoot common wired and wireless connectivity issues
- Address problems related to network services and protocols
- Resolve issues related to network hardware, including routers, switches, and media types

Recommended experience:

- Completed the training for CompTIA A+, Core 1 and Core 2
- 1-2 years total IT experience with 9-12 months of hands-on experience working in a network support or network administration role
- Regardless of whether you have passed A+ or have hands-on experience, it is recommended that you have the following skills and knowledge before starting this course:
- Configure and support PC, laptop, mobile (smartphone / tablet), and print devices
- Know basic network terminology and functions (such as Ethernet, TCP/IP, switches, routers)
- Configure and manage users, groups, and shared resources in a simple SOHO network
- Understand the use of basic access control measures, such as authentication, security policy, encryption, and firewalls
- Understand TCP/IP addressing, core protocols and troubleshooting tools
